Music Class Talent Show

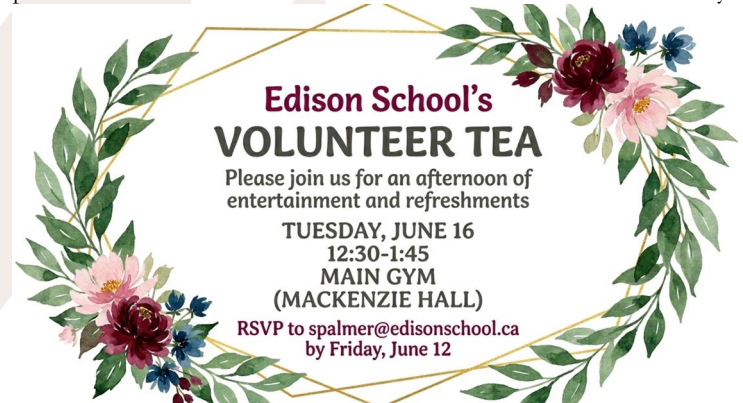

Grade 4 Year-End Trip to Saskatoon Farm

To celebrate a wonderful Grade 4 year, students will spend an afternoon at Saskatoon Farm on Wednesday, June 17. During our visit, students will enjoy a variety of hands-on activities, including a tour of the farm, learning about farming and plant growth, visiting and sketching the animals, planting seeds, and taking a ride through the fields to learn about current crops and growing practices. These activities connect well with our science learning about plants and ecosystems.

Students should bring a water bottle, sunscreen, bug spray, and a hat. They may wear comfortable clothing and footwear appropriate for the weather. Long pants are recommended. Please note that students may be exposed to common farm-related allergens, including animals, hay, and pollen. In the event of inclement weather, the trip will be cancelled. We look forward to a fun and memorable afternoon as we celebrate the end of a great year together!

Grade 4 Little Bow Schoolroom

On June 18, the Grade 4 students will visit the Little Bow Schoolroom in High River for the day. Students will experience what school was like 100 years ago through guided tours, hands-on activities, and learning about local history. Students are encouraged to dress as children would have 100 years ago. They will need to bring a packed lunch, hat, and a water bottle. We look forward to a fun day of learning outside the classroom.

Middle School Cultural Day

This year, our Grade 6 Student Council has organized a Cultural Day for all middle school students (Grades 4–7). This is an opportunity for students to celebrate and share their backgrounds and cultures with one another.
